

Submission Guidelines for the Paper of International Workshop on Tropical Wetlands: Innovation in Mapping and Management for Sustainable Agriculture, on Oct 19-21, 2018

Abstract: Main Title must be placed in the center of the top, and then, after one blank line, Author(s) Name(s), affiliation(s) and Email Address(es) are to be centered beneath the title. The author information is to be followed by one blank line. Abstract should be within limit of 300 words, and Keywords are to follow the abstract with no blank line. Leave two blank lines after the keywords, and then begin Main Text.

Keywords: agriculture, wetlands, swamp, land management, mapping, land use

1. Introduction

Please follow the steps outlined below when preparing your manuscript.

2. Instructions for Manuscripts

Prepare your manuscript in ENGLISH with full-size format on A4 papers. There are **20 pages limitation including images and tables**, of length paper for invited full paper. Your manuscript must be submitted by sending file attachment in **MS WORD and PDF file**.

1) Paper Margins and Format

Leave **25 mm margin on the top and bottom, 25 mm margins on the left and right sides**. Body text must be in a **SINGLE COLUMN FORMAT**.

2) Typefaces and Type Sizes

We strongly encourage all authors to use **TIMES NEW ROMAN FONT FACE 12 point** except Figure and Table captions. If it is not available on your word processor, please use the font closest in appearance to Times.

3) Title and Text Style

Leave a single space before and after headings. Left-justify the section titles including Acknowledgement, References and the subsection titles. In all the titles, capitalize the first letter of nouns, Pronouns, verbs, adjectives, and adverbs; do not capitalize articles, coordinate conjunctions, or repositions, unless the title begins with such a word. All the text in your manuscript should be **FULLY JUSTIFIED** with **SINGLE-SPACING**.

4) Figures and Tables

Figure captions should be placed below the figures; table captions should be placed above the tables. Figures and tables should be numbered in Arabic numerals consecutively in the order to which they are referred. Use the abbreviation "Fig. 1" instead of Figure 1. When you reduce figures, make sure all the labels in them are readable.

5) Other Comments

Abbreviations and acronyms should be defined when they are used for the first time in the text. Give dates in the form of December 13, 2006. Place a zero before decimal points: "0.25," not ".25." Use abbreviations of units only beside numerals: 5 m.

3. Conclusions

Deadline of submission of the tentative abstract is before **September 22, 2018**. To submit your manuscript, please send your full paper as attachment to the workshop organizer before **October 5, 2018** (ksphp.bbsdip@gmail.com).
